Biblical Ministry Objective

Ministry Goals

Spiritual Gifts

Time Required

To be welcoming to people on your assigned days. (The frequency will depend on the number of people on your schedule.)

Term

We would like you to commit for a one-year term, at which time we will ask if you would be willing to continue or would wish to step back from this ministry.

Responsibilities

1. To arrive 15 minutes before worship.
2. Before serving, say a quick prayer that your ministry blesses someone who needs a welcome.
3. To stand near one of the entrance doors, open it for others and greet everyone with a smile and an enthusiastic "Good Morning!"
4. If they seem open to a handshake, you are welcome to do so.
5. If someone does identify themselves as a guest, especially welcome them and answer any questions they might have. (If you get the chance, point them out the pastor.)
6. As you might identify other friendly people, invite them to also serve in this ministry.
7. Please remain at the doors at least five minutes after worship in case anyone arrives late.
