Your box can be dropped off at the church in the air-lock area from **Sunday, October 15-Sunday, November 12**, Monday-Friday after 1:00 pm so as to not conflict with preschool, or anytime on the weekend. Ideally, food should arrive packed in a copier paper type box as this allows us to better stack, but any size will do. Also, if you have any leftover Halloween candy you'd like to donate, please slip that in your box.

We will also be accepting cash donations for turkeys. You can make a check out to St. Paul's with "turkey donation" in the notes and mail to the church.

If you want to help with filling a food basket but don't want to shop, \$25 will cover the cost for a full dinner box. Please put your check in an envelope marked "Food Box Donation" and mail to the church or drop in the offering plate.
