Annual Snow Geese Migration

Everyone is invited to witness the wonder of the annual snow goose migration on **Saturday**, **February 24**, at Middle Creek Wildlife Management Area near Stevens, PA. Every year from mid-February through early March, hundreds of thousands of these birds use Middle Creek as a stopover point on their flight north to Canada and their summer breeding grounds. At peak, there can be as many as 125,000 birds at one time on the lake - quite an amazing sight to see and hear, and a real testament to God's creation. This is a family event, so all children and youth must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Social Ministry is again collecting donations to fill Easter food baskets for those in need in and around the Care Center Foundation in West Chester. Here's how you can help:

- Purchase food to fill a box: Sign up at <u>StPaulsLionville.org/events</u> and click <u>here</u> for a shopping list of the items that make up a complete family dinner.
- Donate funds for the purchase of hams and chickens: Make a check out to St. Paul's with "ham/chicken donation" in the notes and put it in the offering plate or mail it to the church.
- Donate free ham received with grocery bonus points: Please bring it in and we'll put it in the parsonage freezer.

Candy Donations

Both St. Paul's and St. Matthew's are holding egg hunts this year -- St. Paul's on **Saturday evening, March 23**, and St. Matthew's on **Saturday morning, March 30** -- and we need stuff to fill in the eggs! Penny Wars Youth Fundraiser

What are penny wars? We are competing with St. Matthew's to see who can score the most points as we raise money for our shared youth ministry. Two jars are in the gathering area; one for pennies and paper money (which are counted positively toward St. Paul's total) and one for silver coins (which are



counted NEGATIVELY toward St. Matthew's total). Points are determined by the value of the coin or bill (pennies are one point, dollar bills are 100, dimes are -10 points for the other congregation, etc.). When the money is counted after Easter Sunday, the pastor of the losing congregation will star in a special performance involving singing and wearing a costume, and it WILL be memorable! AND, if we raise a combined \$750 or more between the two congregations, our Youth Director Craig Miller will ALSO be involved in the event! Current tally is 1,853 points for St. Paul's and 6,301 points for St. Matthew's.
